# Goal 3: Eliminate plastic pollution in the environment

#### Rio Principle 7



"States shall cooperate in a spirit of global partnership to conserve, protect and restore the health and integrity of the Earth's ecosystem. In view of the different contributions to global environmental degradation, States have common but differentiated responsibilities..."

National Plastic Pollution Prevention Plans (N4Ps) Describe how countries will meet the core goals.

Ambitious and measurable targets.

#### Horizontal policy coherence

Include targets, baselines for indicators, implementation and time frames, harmonized monitoring methodologies.

Reflect increasing levels of ambition over time.

Regular reporting from governments to the secretariat (including meaningful qual and quant data)

A national implementation authority

### Global reporting

Iterative global reviews and reporting pf performance and impacts back to member states

Transparent compliance mechanism

Deal with cases of noncompliance including reporting

State countries' rights to prohibit imports of plastic products from noncompliant parties due to unacceptable risk

# Supporting mechanisms

Funding from both domestic budgets, private sources, and international support

- - additional support for developing countries
- - funds from plastics industry (polluter pays)

Clearing-house to share information about accessing funds.

Funds should promote polluter pays market-based instruments so that countries internalize their own externalities. \*\*\*\*
